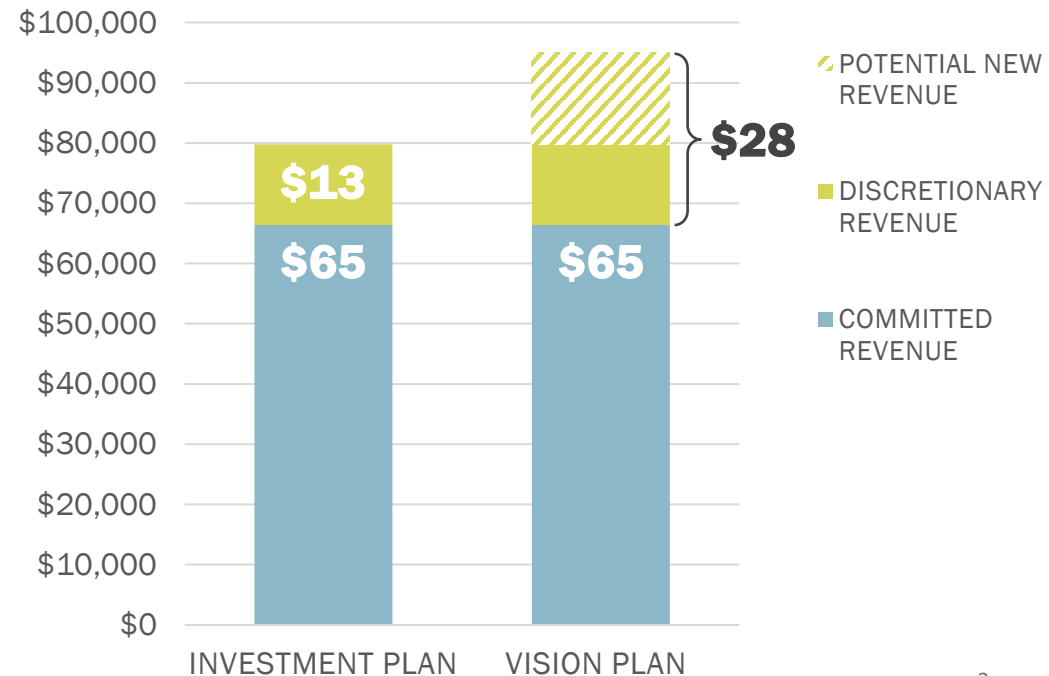
Investment Plan:

~\$80 B in expected transportation revenue for 30 years

Vision Plan:

~\$95 B including potential new revenues

Neighborhood transportation planning and implementation.

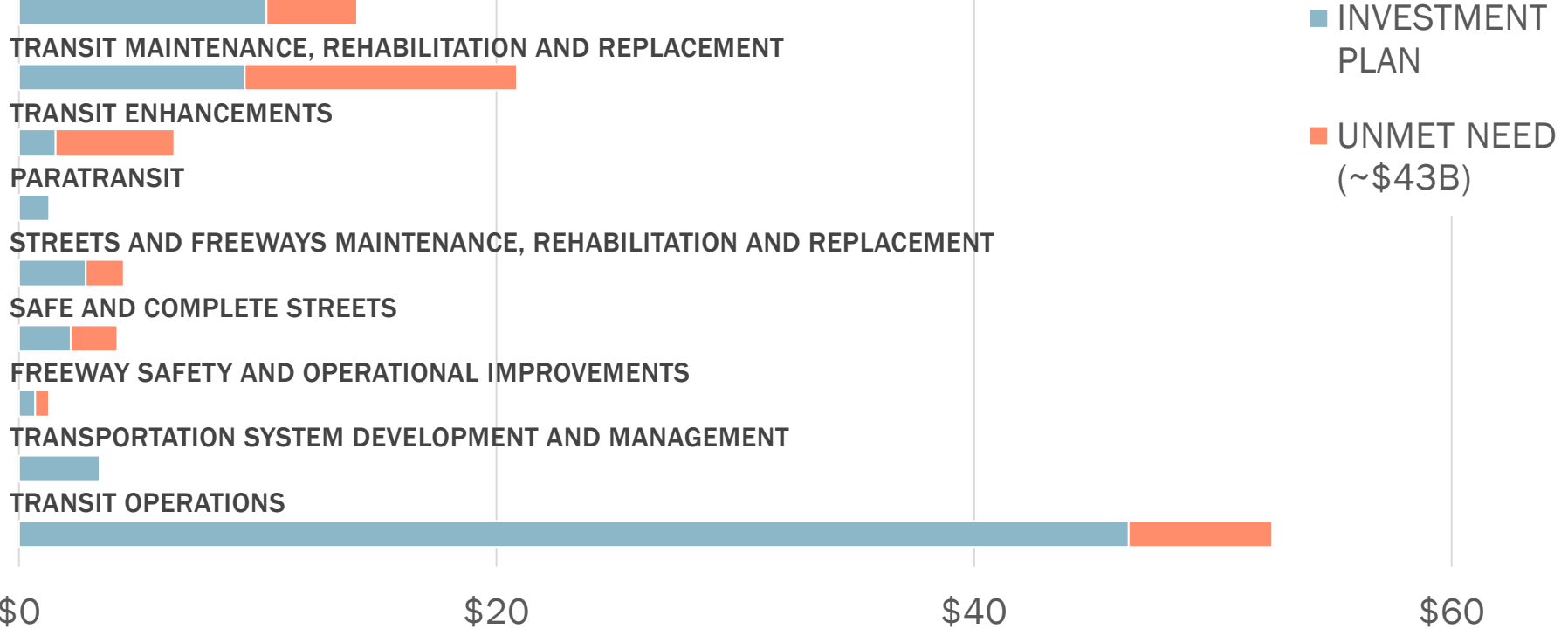

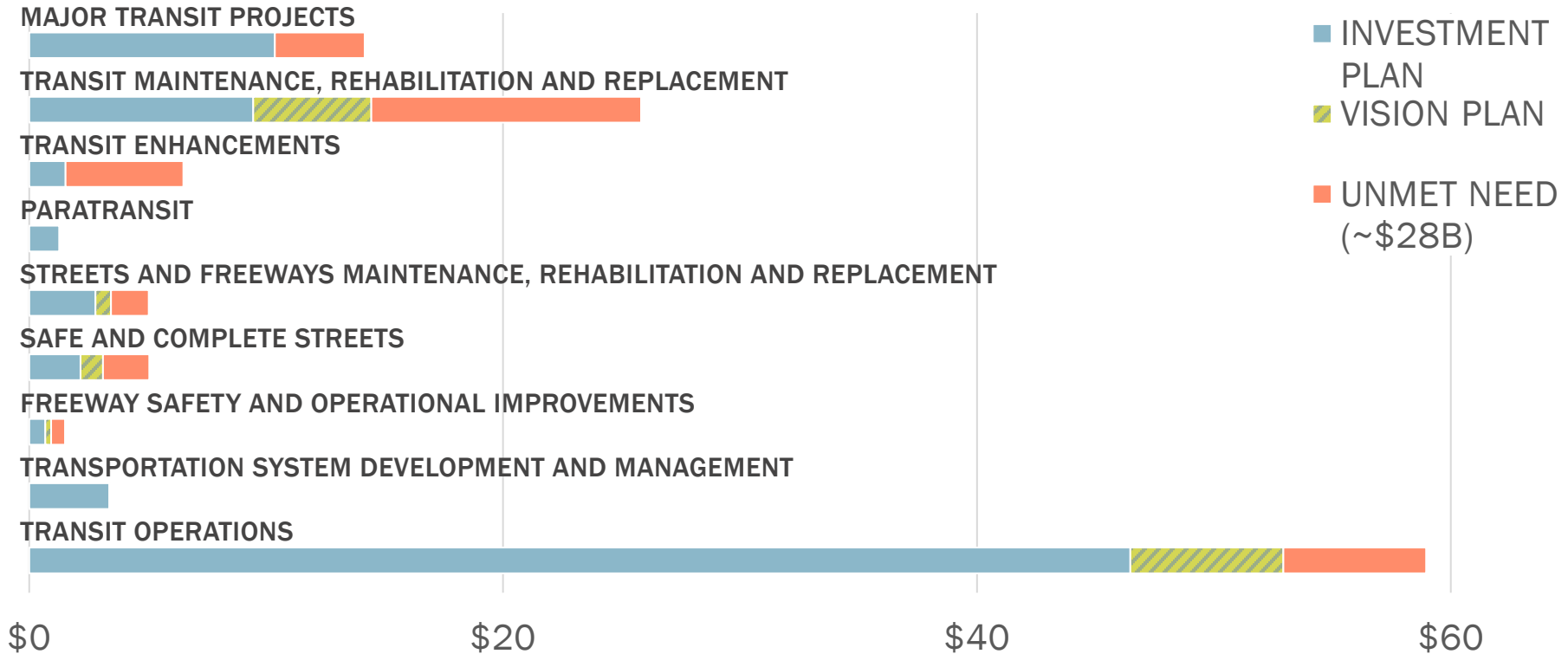

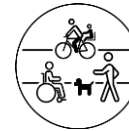
