# What is TFCA?

- Revenues come from a \$4 annual vehicle registration fee
- Funds projects that achieve emission reductions from motor vehicles
- 40% of funds is managed by counties on a return-to-source bases
- SFCTA administers the program in San Francisco

# TFCA FY 24/25 Program

## Call for Projects

Funds available: \$642,779

Funds must be programmed by  
November or returned to the Air District  
Strict eligibility requirements

# TFCA FY 24/25 Program

## Eligibility Screening

### Air District Requirements

- Must be an eligible project type
- Meets cost effectiveness ratio (TFCA \$/ton of emissions reduced):
  - \$500,000 – Alternative Fuel Light- and Medium-Duty Vehicles
  - \$250,000 – Bicycle Parking
  - \$150,000 – Ridesharing Projects (Existing)

# TFCA FY 24/25 Program

## Board Adopted Local Expenditure Criteria

### Projects prioritized based on

- Project Type
- Cost-effective Emissions Reductions
- Project Readiness
- Community Support
- Benefits Equity Priority Communities
- Investment from Non-Public Project Sponsors or Partners
- Project Delivery Track Record
- Program Diversity

# TFCA FY 24/25 Program

Criteria

## Priority order for project types

1. Zero Emissions (non-vehicle)
2. Shuttle Service
3. Alternative Fuel Vehicles
4. Other Eligible

# Project Details

## Emergency Ride Home (SFE) - \$91,775

- Reimbursed taxi ride home in case of personal emergency for those commuting to work in SF by foot, bike, transit, carpool, or shared mobility
- Encourages confidence in sustainable commute modes
- All employees who work in San Francisco are eligible

# Project Details

## Short-Term Bike Parking (SFMTA) - \$506,004

- Procure and install 1,200 racks
- Locations by public request, proactive outreach, high-demand
- Request a rack at: [www.sfmta.com/bikeparking](http://www.sfmta.com/bikeparking)
- 28% of racks installed in Equity Priority Communities since 2021

# Project Details

## Paratransit Electrification (SFMTA) - \$45,000

- Purchase one EV paratransit van to replace a gas vehicle that is beyond its useful life
- Currently no EV paratransit vans in operation
- Testing this vehicle will inform future EV fleet transition
