


YBI Multi-use Path

- Class I multi-use path from YBI bike landing to Treasure Island Ferry Terminal
- Path width: 12' 16'
- New transit lane along Treasure Island Road
- Part of the Multimodal Bay Skyway Project








YBI Multi-use Path Contract Amendment

- WMH Corporation awarded 2-year professional services contract in an amount not to exceed \$1,150,000 for 35% design for YBI Multiuse Path (MUP) Segments 3 and 4 in November 2024
- Bay Area Toll Authority (BATA) approved \$750,000 for design of the YBI Transit Lane Project on December 11, 2024
- Prop AA appropriation for \$750,000 will match BATA funds
- Transit Lane added to YBI MUP
- Transit Lane is a mitigation requirement of Treasure Island EIR



YBI Multi-use Path Contract Amendment

- Transit only lane for buses and emergency vehicles. TI Ferry Terminal to I-80 Bay Bridge West Span on-ramp
- Increase WMH contract by \$1,500,000 to complete design from 35% to 100%
- YBI MUP Segment 3 and 4 Design: January 2025 Spring 2026
- WMH team DBE participation:
 27%
