

RESOLUTION APPOINTING RAYMON SMITH TO THE CITIZENS ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE SAN FRANCISCO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM

WHEREAS, Section 131265(d) of the California Public Utilities Code, as implemented by Section 5.3(a) of the Administrative Code of the San Francisco County Transportation Authority, requires the appointment of a Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) consisting of eleven members; and

WHEREAS, There is one vacancy on the CAC; and

WHEREAS, At its July 15, 2014 meeting, after careful review and consideration of all candidates' qualifications and experience, the Plans and Programs Committee unanimously recommended the appointment of Raymon Smith to serve for a period of two years; now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the San Francisco County Transportation Authority does hereby appoint Raymon Smith to serve, for a two-year term, on the CAC of the San Francisco County Transportation Authority; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the Executive Director is authorized to communicate this information to all interested parties.
