






Alemany Interchange Improvement Study: Study Area

Improvement Benefits: Road-diet and Buffered Bicycle Lane





Improvement Benefit: Painted Bulb Outs








Improvement Benefits: Multi-Use Path







Implementation Strategies



- Phase 1: Road-diet, buffered bicycle lane and painted curb bulb-outs – FUNDED
 - ► Estimated total cost (approximate)- \$277K
 - ► Funded through NTIP Capital Funds
 - ► SFMTA leads design, construction
 - ► Estimated completion date mid-2018

- Phase 2: Multi-use path
 - ► Estimated total (approximate)- \$2.2 million
 - ► Project area survey and preliminary design FUNDED
 - ► SFDPW lead coordination with SFMTA, and Caltrans
