One Bay Area Grant Cycle 2 (OBAG 2) Revised Programming Recommendations

- ► July 2017 3 projects approved (\$21.5 million):
 - ► Caltrain Electrification (\$11.2 million)
 - ► Geary Bus Rapid Transit (\$6.9 million)
 - ► John Yehall Chin Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Capital Project (\$3.4 million)
- ► 3 projects deferred for questions and follow up (\$20.8 million):
 - Better Market Street Design (\$16 million)
 - ► Embarcadero BART Station Elevator and Faregates (\$2 million)
 - ► SRTS Non-Infrastructure Project (\$2.81 million)
- ► Prop AA \$2.065 million Strategic Plan amendment for Geary BRT project (Phase 2)

- ► BART elevator status report available in next month

- Project update at July 25 Board meeting

- Create new \$750k SRTS Capital Improvements Placeholder

- Support for recommended SRTS Non-Infrastructure project
- Concern over SRTS Non-Infrastructure program effectiveness
- ► Interest in capital SRTS improvements
- Desire for expanded crossing guard program
- ▶ Desire to address pick up and drop off conflicts

SRTS Capital Improvements Placeholder

TRANCISCO COUNTY

Recommendation:

- New \$750k placeholder recommendation
- Funds available in late 2020
- Project(s) identified by school walking audits, Vision Zero planning, pick up and drop off analysis, other planning
- ▶ Return to Board in ~1 year to approve specific project recommendations



Possible capital improvements:

- Crosswalks and speed humps
- ► Intersection improvements
- Signals and signs
- Bicycle improvements
- Pick up and drop off improvements

Options for SRTS Action

- 1. Program \$2.06 million to the SRTS Non-Infrastructure program (25% reduction) and create new \$750k SRTS Capital Improvements Placeholder (revised staff rec.)
 - ► Submit quarterly progress reports (including reporting on performance, participation)
 - ► Return to Board with recommendation for use of SRTS capital improvements funds in about 1 year
- 2. Fully fund SRTS Non-Infrastructure Project at \$2.8 million
- 3. Program other amount for SRTS Capital Improvements Placeholder

Additional Requirements for Consideration:

- a. Annual report to Board on Non-Infrastructure progress, performance, participation
- b. Report to Board on program-wide evaluation criteria
- c. Report back on capital project pipeline development approach

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
