## SRTS Non-Infrastructure Project Revised Staff Recommendation

- Program \$2,813,264 in OBAG 2 funds to the SRTS Non-Infrastructure project
- Lead agency shift from Department of Public Health (DPH) to San Francisco Municipal Transportation Agency (SFMTA) with 2019 school year
- Conditioned upon SFMTA providing:
  - By March 30, 2018, proposal for modifying the crossing guard program
  - By June 30, 2018, report on transition
  - By June 30, 2018, proposal for capital program for school areas
  - Annual progress reports

# SRTS Non-Infrastructure Project Proposed Changes

- New organizational structure
  - SFMTA as lead
- Better coordination across all SRTS programs
  - Capital safety projects near schools
  - Crossing guard program
  - Transit services for youth

Expanded program to encompass all SFUSD schools

- Based on needs assessment
- Continued robust partnerships
  - DPH, SF Unified School District
  - Consultants (Walk SF, SF Bicycle Coalition, Ybike, Safe Passage)


