Replace 30 30-foot Hybrid Diesel Motor Coaches (SFMTA) – Design





- Prop K request: \$356,422
- Scope:
 - Issue Request for Proposals
 - Evaluate bids, select vendor
 - Negotiate contract
- Replace buses at end of useful lives
- Serving community routes (e.g., 35-Eureka, 36-Teresita, 37-Corbett and 56-Rutland)
- Contract award December 2018, new buses in service June 2020

Track Replacement and Upgrade (SFMTA) – Design, Construction







- Prop K request: \$4.48 million, leverages \$18 million in federal funds
 - Rehab or replace track and support systems at ~20 intersections
 - Reduce vibrations, noise, potential for derailment
 - Increase system reliability, productivity
- No LRV service interruption during rehabs; bus substitution during replacement work
 - Construction June 2018 to 2023

Alemany Interchange Improvements Phase 2 [NTIP Capital] (SFPW) – Design



- Prop K request: \$400,000
- Safety, accessibility improvements
 - New multi-use path to Farmers Market, signalized crossings, curb ramps, stormwater management
- Design done by Dec 2018
- Open for use Spring 2020 (pending construction funding)



Lower Great Highway Pedestrian Improvements [NTIP Capital] (SFMTA) – Design, Construction







- Prop K request: \$250,000
- Community engagement and evaluation, implement traffic calming measures Lincoln to Sloat
- May include daylighting, signage, angled parking, medians, speed humps
- Near-term construction done by Summer 2018, mid-term done by Spring 2019

Bayshore Blvd/Cesar Chavez St/Potrero Ave Intersection Improvements (The Hairball) [NTIP Capital] (SFPW) – Construction





- Prop K request: \$320,000
 - ► Total cost of phase: \$528,000
 - Fulfills Intent to Allocate
- Design funded with NTIP capital funds
 - Safer, wider, resurfaced ped/bike path
 - Regraded for adequate clearance, proper drainage
- Construction to begin September 2018
- Open for use December 2018
