SUBJECT: Valencia Bikeway Improvements Project Update – Stakeholder Interviews

On March 1, 2018, a memorandum was sent to the SFCTA Board of Commissioners, summarizing the status and anticipated next steps of the Valencia Bikeway Improvements project. Information was provided regarding the project website and materials, merchant door-to-door outreach, stakeholder interviews, data collection, near-term improvements, and next steps.

This memorandum provides additional updates on the progress of the stakeholder interviews in conjunction with the project team’s presentations at the March 20th SFCTA Board Meeting and at the March 28th SFCTA Citizen Advisory’s Committee Meeting.

Stakeholder Interviews

The project team has invited an additional four local stakeholders, for a total of 41, via e-mail and phone calls for 30-45 minute long stakeholder interviews. The groups that have recently been invited are San Francisco Transit Riders Union, SF Rising, CC Puede, and JUMP. Meeting topics include safety, curb management, and enforcement. The project team structures these interviews as listening sessions to understand how stakeholder groups view important traffic safety issues for those who live, work, visit, and or/travel on the Valencia corridor.

As of March 16, the project team has completed an additional eight stakeholder interviews, for a total of 15, with another six interviews scheduled. Due to the overwhelming response from stakeholder groups, the project team will continue stakeholder interviews until the end of March. A list of the advisory committees, advocate groups, community groups, neighborhood associations, places of worships, schools, and transportation network companies/ courier services that the project team has contacted are included below.
