# Contract 34 Signal Modifications – Additional Funds (SFMTA) Construction



- Prop K request: \$1,218,680  
Prior allocation: \$4,860,000
  - Additional funds to cover higher than expected construction bids
  - Funds available from fully funded or delayed projects
- Traffic signal upgrades at 15 locations across the city
  - 9 intersections on Vision Zero High Injury Network
- 4-month delay to schedule, project to be done by April 2019

# Arguello Signal Upgrades (SFMTA) Construction



- Prop K request: \$775,000
- Prop AA request: \$655,000
- Signal upgrades at six intersections between Lake and Turk
  - All on Vision Zero High Injury Network
  - Lake/ Sacramento, California, Euclid, Clement, Anza, and Turk/ Balboa
- More funds needed than anticipated
  - Prop AA funds programmed to project
  - Prop K funds needed for expected cost increase due to bidding environment
  - Funds available from fully funded or delayed projects
- Coordinated with Arguello paving
- Open for use by December 2019

- Prop K request: \$154,200
- Create branding for SF TDM programs and services
  - Program name, logo, graphic and usage standards
- Recommended in City's Interagency TDM Strategy
- Partner agencies will be involved in development
  - SFMTA, SFCTA, SF Environment, Planning Department
- Program to be developed by December 2020



# Business Relocation Transportation Demand Management (SFMTA) – Planning

- Prop K request: \$383,000
- Identifies new or relocated businesses and encourages employees not to drive to work alone
- Work to be done by SFMTA and SF Environment
- Phase 1: develop program by December 2018
- Phase 2 & 3: implement and evaluate program from January 2019 – June 2020
