What is TFCA?



- ► Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) funds come from a \$4 vehicle registration for projects that achieve emission reductions from motor vehicles
- ► 40% managed by counties on a return-to-source basis SFCTA administers program in San Francisco





FY 2018/19 TFCA Program



Fiscal Year 2018/19 TFCA Call for Projects:

- ► Funds available for projects: \$764,243
- ► Six applications received requesting \$1,209,996

Staff recommendation:

- ► Approve Part 1 of the FY2018/19 TFCA Program of Projects, programming \$388,003
- ► Place \$376,240 in FY2018/19 TFCA funds on reserve, to be programmed following a second call for projects

FY 2018/19 TFCA Program Eligibility Screening



- **►** Eligible Project Type
- Meets cost effectiveness (CE) ratio (TFCA \$/ton of emissions reduced)
 - ▶\$150k/ton for Ridesharing projects
 - ▶\$150k/ton for Trip Reduction projects
 - ▶\$250k/ton for Bicycle projects
 - ► \$250k/ton for Alternative Fuel Infrastructure projects

FY 2018/19 TFCA Program Local Expenditure Criteria



- ► Priority order for project types:
 - ▶ 1) Zero emissions non-vehicle projects
 - ▶2) Shuttle services
 - ▶3) Alternative fuel vehicles/infrastructure
 - ▶ 4) Any other eligible project
- Projects prioritized based on cost- effective emissions reductions
- Project readiness, program diversity, and recent delivery track-record also considered

FY 2018/19 TFCA Program Staff Recommendation



► Ridesharing/Trip Reduction Projects:

Emergency Ride Home - \$50,734

- ► Free or low cost ride home in cases of emergency for employees
- Outreach targeting businesses and commuters


FY 2018/19 TFCA Program Staff Recommendation



▶ Bicycle Project:

Bike Cage at SF State Thornton Hall - \$40,069

- ► Secure storage for 118 bicycles
- ► Access with campus ID or access card



FY 2018/19 TFCA Program Staff Recommendation



► Alternative Fuel Infrastructure:

Off-Street Car Share Electrification – DC Fast Chargers - \$127,200

- ► Install 2 DC Fast Chargers at 2 Maven carshare parking spots first all electric carshare vehicle option in SF
- ► Requires TFCA policy waiver

Grace Cathedral DC Fast Chargers - \$170,000

- ▶ 2 DCFC at Grace Cathedral garage
- ► Chargers available seven days a week for church members, visitors, employees of the Cathedral
