Prop K 5YPPs Designated Elements



Each 5YPP includes:

- Prioritization methodology
- 5-year program (or list) of projects with funding and cash flow by fiscal year
- Project Information Forms with scope, schedule, cost, and funding
- Performance measures
- Project delivery status



2019 5YPP Update What we look for



- What's happened in the past/now
 - Delivery track record, leveraging, reimbursement rates
- What's proposed
 - Project specific: project readiness, leveraging, reimbursement rates
 - Category specific and programwide: % of funds spent on financing for the category, when do funds run out?

2019 5YPP Update NTIP Cycle 2



- ▶ 2019 5YPP
 - ▶ \$7.7 million for NTIP Cycle 2 grants
 - \$700,000 per district: \$100,000 planning + \$600,000 local match for capital projects (same as Cycle 1)
 - Program administration
 - Placeholders in six categories
 - Carryforward policy
 - Each district can carry forward up to \$300,000 in unallocated
 NTIP funds (max \$1 million per district in 2019 5YPP)

 - Carryforward TransitPerformance Initiative funds
- ▶ 2019 5YPP

2019 5YPP Update Caltrain State of Good Repair Categories



Capital Improvement Program, Vehicles, Facilities and Guideways

- 2014 5YPP amendment
 - Add FY18/19 projects, funds already programmed
- ▶ 2019 5YPP
 - Local Capital Match Placeholders for each category
 - ► Total of \$7.5M in FY19/20 and FY20/21 across the categories
 - Prop K funds substantially run out in FY20/21

- Carryforward \$7.6 million for six projects in 2019 5YPP

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2019 5YPP Update Vehicles Muni & Discretionary



2014 5YPP amendment

- Advance cash flow for \$126 million to support potential accelerated LRV delivery schedule, with conditions
- Carryforward \$37 million

▶ 2019 5YPPs

- Program additional \$34.9 million for LRV procurement, with conditions
 - \$189.2 million total Prop K funds for LRV procurement
- Historic Streetcar rehabilitation, placeholder
- Funds expected to run out after this 5-year period





2019 5YPP Update Facilities - Muni



- 2014 5YPP amendment
 - Advance \$8 million to FY18/19 to add:
 - Muni Metro East (MME) Expansion (planning)
 - Potrero Facility Reconstruction* (planning)
 - Presidio Lifts (construction)
- ▶ 2019 5YPP
 - Muni Metro East Expansion
 - New Castro Station Elevator
 - Placeholder






2019 5YPP Update Facilities - Discretionary



- ▶ 2019 5YPP
 - Potrero Facility Reconstruction (SFMTA)
 - Embarcadero Station: New Northside Platform Elevator (BART) local match to OBAG grant



2019 5YPP Update Guideways - Muni



- 2014 5YPP amendment
 - Advance \$8.6 million to FY18/19
 - L-Taraval
 - 22-Fillmore
 - Quint Jerrold Connector Road (rightof-way)
- ▶ 2019 5YPP
 - Placeholders
 - overhead lines
 - rail replacement
 - cable car system
 - train control systems
 - Quint Jerrold Connector Road (thru an approved fund exchange)





2019 5YPP Update Guideways - Discretionary



▶ 2019 5YPP

- Two Central Subway Fund Exchanges to Help Backfill Regional Improvement Program (RIP) Shortfall
 - Better Market Street (SFPW) \$15.98 million in OBAG 2 funds
 - L- Taraval (SFMTA) –\$4 million in Prop K funds to this project, enables SFMTA to redirect Prop B General Funds to Central Subway
 - Reduces remaining RIP commitment from \$61.75 million to \$40.75 million
- Caltrain Electrification
 - Additional \$5 M in Prop K
 - Fulfills San Francisco's \$80 million commitment to the project



2019 5YPP Update New and Upgraded Streets



- 2014 5YPP amendment
 - Carryforward \$3.3 million for 3 projects
 - Add Great Highway TerminusNarrowing (design) in FY18/19

2014 5YPP amendment

- Carryforward \$1.26 million from projects funded by other sources or advancing in the 2019 5YPP
- Reprogram funds to new FY18/19 projects
 - Ocean Avenue Safety Improvements
 - Excelsior Neighborhood Traffic Calming
 - Sloat Skyline Intersection Improvements
- Increase funds in FY18/19 for John Yehall Chin Safe Routes to School
