 - **▶** Nine intersections
 - ▶ Pedestrian countdown signals, accessible pedestrian signals, better pole placement
- WalkFirst High-Injury Corridor
- Construction: December 2015-December 2016
 - ► Coordinated with Polk Street Streetscape






- ► Prop K Request: \$100,000
- Advance design for bike and ped improvements at three key sites
 - **▶** Wider and/or separated paths
 - ► Accessibility upgrades for existing steep grades
- Lighting plan for intersection area
- Outreach to stakeholders, walk and bike audit
- Conceptual designs completed by June 2016


Cesar Chavez/ Bayshore/ Potrero Intersection Improvements [NTIP Capital] (SFMTA) - Design




- ► Prop K Request: \$100,000
