### Summary of Requests



### Total of \$10 million in Prop K funds requested:

- Eight projects for Caltrain's annual capital budget
- Quint-Jerrold Connector Road
- ► 4<sup>th</sup> Street Bridge (Segment A of Third St Light Rail) Settlement
- Street repair and cleaning equipment
- District 3 Neighborhood
   Transportation Improvement Program
   (NTIP) Planning
- Two transportation demand management projects





## Annual Member Share Contribution to Caltrain (PCJPB) Capital Budget



- ► Amount negotiated among member agencies each year (San Francisco, San Mateo, Santa Clara)
- ▶ Prop K to provide San Francisco's 1/3 member share of Caltrain's capital budget, SFMTA provides member share of operating budget
- Prop K annual programming from 4 categories:
  - ► Caltrain CIP, Vehicles, Facilities, Guideways
- ► FY 15/16 share requires Strategic Plan (SP) Amendment:
  - ▶ 1) \$3,872,301 in the adopted 2014 SP
  - ▶ 2) \$787,844 through proposed SP amendment to increase funds in the Caltrain CIP and Vehicles categories
  - ▶ 3) \$381,585 available from Fiscal Year 2014/15 programming capacity

- Prop K Request: \$2,029,582
- ► Funds for SFMTA's share of settlement costs for the 4th Street Bridge seismic retrofit and rehabilitation project (Segment A of Third Street Light Rail)
- ▶ Prop K Strategic Plan amendment to amend policy and advance funding for grandfathered project
- City and Federal Highway
   Administration contributions

## Quint-Jerrold Connector Road (SFCTA/SFPW)





#### Prop K Request:

- ► \$1,914,000 for right-of-way procurement (SFPW)
- ► \$17,350 for additional archaeological staff work and ongoing design review (SFPW)
- ► \$75,000 for consultant for archaeological investigation (SFCTA)
- **▶** Special Conditions to cover risk

## Street Equipment (SFPW)






- Prop K Request: \$738,072
- ► Funds replacement of city's street repair and cleaning equipment:
  - ▶ 1 flusher truck
  - ▶ 2 high pressure surface cleaners
  - ▶ 1 bike path sweeper
- Replaces similar equipment that has exceeded useful life
- Equipment on streets for use by May 2017

### Commute Benefits Ordinance Employer Outreach (SFE)

- Prop K Request: \$79,872
- Scope includes:
  - Administer and conduct outreach to employers for Commuter Benefits Ordinance
  - Track program performance
  - Update compliance process
- Funds work through September 2016

### Kearny Street Multimodal Implementation Plan [NTIP Planning] (SFMTA)





- Prop K Request: \$100,000
- Builds on SFCTA's Chinatown Neighborhood Transportation Plan
- District 3 NTIP study goals include:
  - ► Improve ped safety
  - ► Enhance Muni performance
  - Develop bike facilities
- Engagement with Supervisor's Office, community, and other stakeholders
- Final report by December 2016

### San Francisco BART Travel Incentive Program (SFCTA)







- Prop K Request: \$45,800
- SFCTA-BART Partnership
  - ► Innovative pilot program to incentivize riders to shift travel to shoulders of peak
  - **▶** Includes project evaluation
- Leverages \$900k in BART and federal funds
- ► 6-9 month pilot expected to start spring 2016
