

### Next Phase of the OBAG Program

- ▶ Region's federal funding (CMAQ/STP\*) framework to support CA climate law and Plan Bay Area
- Another 5 year program
  - ▶ OBAG 1: 2012-2016
  - ► OBAG 2: 2017-2021
- ► Overall 4% decline in revenues (\$827m → \$790m)
  - ▶ No new categories
  - ► Mostly maintain or reduce funding for existing programs
  - ▶ In general maintain split

Regional programs: 55%

**County programs: 45%** 



#### Reward Counties that Provide Housing, Especially Affordable Housing



- ▶ OBAG County Program distribution formula still being determined
- ► We want a County Program formula that gives a greater weight to housing production and affordable housing share
- San Francisco share increases for OBAG 2

**11.7%** → **12.3%~13.4%**

## Link Funding to Affordable Housing and Anti-Displacement Policies

- CONNECTING OUR COMMUNITY
- ► Anti-displacement and affordable housing are major topics of interest in Plan Bay Area 2040 discussions
- ► We want OBAG 2 to support policies to address these concerns
- Do this through Regional Planning funding program?



### Toward a More Transparent and Inclusive Regional Operations Program

- **▶** Regional Operations Program includes
  - ► Freeway Performance Optimization
  - ► Transportation Management
  - ► Other regionwide coordination efforts (511, Rideshare)
- We want the program to:
  - ▶ Be better defined
  - ▶ Be developed transparently
  - ► Consider multi-modal corridors



### Prioritize the Transit Priorities Program for Additional Revenues

- CONNECTING OUR COMMUNITY
- ► Transit Priorities Program supports core capacity improvements and state of good repair
  - **►** Transit Capital Priorities
  - **►** Transit Performance Initiatives
- ► Current OBAG 2 proposal: \$201m → \$189m
- We want MTC to commit to increase funding if additional funding is secured

Late 2016 - Early 2017	MTC approval of CMA projects
After July 1, 2017	OBAG 2 funding available

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
