

### Treasure Island Mobility Management Program (SFCTA)






- Prop K Request: \$210,000 Environmental and Design work Total cost: \$5.7 million
- Scope includes
  - Environmental document approvals
  - Final system engineering design
  - ► Final System Engineering Management Plan
- Completion of design and environmental phases by June 2017; project open for use (start of operations) in January 2019




- Prop K Request: \$48,000
- Community-Based Planning for Folsom/Howard Streets
- How can Folsom and Howard redesigns best address pedestrian safety and access to schools, recreation centers, etc. within the zone
- Planning to be completed by June 2017



# District 6 NTIP Planning- Part 2 (SFCTA)

TRANCISCO COURTY ALLANON AUTHOR

- Prop K Request: \$52,000
- Vision Zero Ramp Intersection Study
  - Develop recommendations for improving safety at 3-5 ramp intersections in the zone. Likely locations:
    - I-80 Westbound off-ramp at 5th and Harrison Streets
    - ► I-80 Eastbound on-ramp at 5th and Bryant Streets
    - US 101 SB on-ramp at 10th and Bryant Streets
    - US 101 off-ramp to 9th and Bryant Streets
- Final report anticipated by June 2017



# Bulb-outs at WalkFirst Locations (SFMTA)






- Prop AA Request: \$491,757 Design
- Will leverage \$5 million in SFMTA revenue bonds for the construction phase
- Upgrade up to 25 existing painted safety zones to permanent concrete bulb-outs on Pedestrian High Injury Corridors
- SFMTA will select the highest priority locations
- Construction to begin in spring 2018

### Chinatown Broadway Phase IV (SFPW)





- Prop AA Request: \$1,029,839
- Leverages \$6.2 million from OBAG, Prop AA, Prop K, and other state and local funds for construction
- Complete street improvements from Columbus to Broadway Tunnel
- Covers the higher-thananticipated bids
- Construction June 2016 -April 2017

### Mansell Corridor Improvement (SFMTA)





- Prop AA Request: \$163,358
- ► Leverages \$5.7 million from OBAG, Prop AA, Prop K, and other state and local funds for construction
- Complete street improvements on Mansell between Visitacion Avenue and Dublin Street
- Covers higher-thananticipated bids
- Construction underway;
   open for use August 2016
