

- Expanded data transmission and simulcasting








Design-Build Contract

On June 20, 2012 SFMTA issued NTP to Harris Corporation

- Construction, testing and configuration is nearing completion at the radio base stations
- Construction is also taking place at 16 aboveground locations and the Metro subway system
- Four above-ground radio base stations have been completed and are on-the-air
- All base stations are in the system setup and configuration stage



Project Moving to Testing and Installation Phase

- Factory acceptance testing for rubber-tire fleet completed
- Installation complete on nine revenue buses and 4 non-revenue vehicles
- Mini-fleet testing in May
- Complete rubber-tire installation in September
- LRV factory testing in June
- LRV installation September '16 to January '17
- Historic fleet installation January to March '17

- ► To date, an SBE participation of 32% of billings






Challenges
