Wiggle Neighborhood Green Corridor (SFMTA) Construction



- ► Prop K request: \$647,000
 - ► Leverages \$2 million, primarily Wastewater Bond funds for SFPUC's green infrastructure
- Between Church/Duboce and Fell/Scott intersections
- Bike signal, bulb-outs, raised crosswalks, roadway markings
- Outreach done since 2013
- Construction spring 2017 through June 2018



Bayshore/Cesar Chavez/Potrero (The Hairball) [NTIP Capital] (SFPW) - Design






- ► Prop K request: \$80,000
 - ► Includes NTIP Capital funds from both Districts 9 and 10
 - ► Commitment to allocate \$320,000 in Districts 9 and 10 NTIP Capital funds for construction
- Recommendations from SFMTA's NTIP-funded report
 - Bicycle and pedestrian improvements at the western entrance to the Hairball adjacent to westbound Cesar Chavez Street
- Design complete by fall 2017



Segment F and G: Proposed Project



- A. Entry ramp widened and resurfaced at Cesar Chavez
- B. EB shared bike/pedestrian path widened from 6 ft to10 ft for shared/flexible
- C. New green buffer installed to set back pathway from the road/highway on-ramp
- D. New retaining walls and abutment installed
- E. Pathway regraded to allow for sufficient clearance at highway overpass








- Prop K request: \$100,000
 - ► Matches \$300,00 Caltrans Planning Grant
- Community planning for Green Connections Network and Bicycle Strategy for three key corridors:
 - Cayuga/Alemany
 - ► Persia/Brazil/Russia
 - ► Naples-Brunswick
- Develop designs to improve livability and vitality of local streets
- ► Planning to conclude by fall 2018


Filbert & Leavenworth Pavement Renovation (SFPW) Construction



- Prop K request: \$3.48 million
- 25 blocks (2.2 miles) to be paved on Filbert, Baker to Jones, and Leavenworth, Union to Jefferson
 - ► Paving and road base repairs
 - ► ~106 new curb ramps
 - ► Sidewalk and curb repairs
- Joint project with SFPUC sewer
- Construction to start summer 2017, open for use fall 2018

Brannan Street Pavement Renovation (SFPW) Construction





- ► Prop AA request: \$2.54 million
- ▶ 21 blocks (1.54 miles) to be paved on Brannan from The Embarcadero to intersection of 10th/ Division/Potrero Avenue
 - ► Paving and road base repairs
 - ►~52 new curb ramps
 - ► sidewalk and curb repairs
- Construction to start summer 2017, open for use fall 2018
