## What is TFCA?



- Transportation Fund for Clean Air (TFCA) funds come from a \$4 per vehicle surcharge collected by the DMV on motor vehicle registrations in the nine-county Bay Area region
- 60% of TFCA funds managed by the Bay Area Air Quality Management District (Air District)
- 40% of TFCA funds managed by counties SFCTA administers program in San Francisco
- Provides funds to projects which reduce motor vehicle emissions and improve air quality

## **TFCA Basics**



- In Fiscal Year 2017/18 we expect to have approximately \$722,000 in TFCA funds to program to eligible projects
- Air District regulations establish project eligibility and require counties to adopt local expenditure criteria to guide the selection of local projects
- Usually only four to eight projects funded per year
- Diverse range of project types funded by TFCA in San Francisco



# TFCA Local Expenditure Criteria

TRANSOO COLLARY ALLON

- Priority order for project types:
  - ▶ 1) Zero emissions non-vehicle projects
  - ► 2) Shuttle services
  - ► 3) Alternative fuel vehicles/infrastructure
  - ► 4) Any other eligible project
- Projects prioritized based on cost- effective emissions reductions
- Project deliverability, program diversity, and prior grant performance also considered

# TFCA Policy Changes for FY 2017/18




- The Air District modified a few policies governing the TFCA program for this year
- Key changes include:
  - Increased the cost-effectiveness limit for shuttle projects
  - Allowed upgrades to an existing bicycle facility
  - Relaxed requirements for bike share projects
  - Revised policy language for Alternative Fuel Light-Duty Vehicles and Alternative Fuel Heavy-Duty Vehicles and Buses categories
  - Added On-Road Goods Movement Truck Replacements as an eligible category

# Proposed Schedule for Fiscal Year 2017/18 TFCA Call for Projects



January 25, 2017	CAC acts on Local Expenditure Criteria
February 28, 2017	Transportation Authority Board acts on Local Expenditure Criteria
By March 7, 2017	Transportation Authority issues TFCA Call for Projects
April 28, 2017	Applications due to the Transportation Authority
May 24, 2017	CAC adopts project priorities
June 27, 2017	Transportation Authority Board adopts project priorities
Aug/Sep 2017	Funds expected to be available to project sponsors
