 - ▶ Vision scenario assuming new revenues


PAST INITATIVES> RECENT TRENDS> UPCOMING EFFORT

- Required General Plan element per CA law
- Codification of City's transportation goals,
 policies and long-term investment priorities
- All City actions and investments must be consistent with General Plan
- Updated on less frequent basis (last update in 1995 post 4-Corridors Plan)
- ► Topics include:
 - System/mode share goals
 - Transportation Demand Management
 - Street and mode network classification (e.g. Bike Network, Transit Preferential Streets, Freight Routes)
 - Priority corridors for high-capacity transit investment
 - Regional connectivity
 - Land Use-transportation coordination
