Statement of qualifications for membership:

My name is Winston Parsons and I respectfully request to be re-appointed to the Geary BRT CAC. I have a great passion for learning more about and improving urban planning and design, specifically regarding transportation. I would love to stay involved in a project that has such a large potential for improving public transit, pedestrian safety, and quality of life for San Franciscans. I believe I have the right mindset, ideas, and background to work on a team advising the CTA on this project. Having grown up several blocks from Geary (Presidio Ave and Bush St) and now a current resident on Geary Boulevard (Geary and Spruce St, specifically - District 2), I've lived in the neighborhood almost my entire life. I've also used MUNI since I was in middle school, the 38 and 38L particularly when I was studying at SF State. I also grew up in a household with two former generations of San Franciscans, which affords me some anecdotal insights into the design and effectiveness of Geary Blvd over the years. I recognize the importance of balancing the uses of streets so that people using the street in different ways are represented in the corridor's design and function. Furthermore, having grown up near Bush and Pine Street, and now living on Geary. I have an acute appreciation for the potential improvement in air quality (especially with new, more efficient busses) BRT offers. I've also earned a minor in Urban Planning at San Francisco State University and worked a semester editing for their urban planning journal, Urban Action.

My former roles working for the YMCA's Bicycle program, YBike (www.ybike.org), had me I working at various after-school programs (primarily at Roosevelt Middle School, on Geary and Arguello) as a youth bicycle educator. I led after-school bike clubs at schools at schools in SF and San Mateo, including Roosevelt M.S on Geary & Arguello, where I taught kids how to ride bikes safely and responsibly on the road. Leading a group of roughly 12 kids on rides throughout the area means I've gained an intimate knowledge of how the streets in the surrounding neighborhoods work, which ones are safe to ride on, and how the youth and their families use the area.

In my time serving on the CAC, I've given feedback to staff on a number of specific project issues and the project as a whole. I've also attended Geary BRT outreach meetings (both in my district and outside) to engage with members of the public; sharing the with them the deliberation that happens in the CAC meetings and bringing their feedback to the other members.

I believe all of the previous reasons make me well qualified for the Geary BRT CAC, and with your permission would like to continue serving on the Committee.
