- Prop K Request: \$20.4 million
- Prop K share of the total \$276.4 million milestone payment to the concessionaire (GLC)
- Upon substantial completion of Phase II, which is anticipated in September 24, 2015

- Prop K Request: \$12,352,094
- Leverages \$68M in non-Prop K funds
 - 26 replacement funded with Prop K
 - ► 35 expansion
 - **Contract awarded to New Flyer**
 - First vehicle in limited revenue service May 2015, all vehicles delivered by February 2016
- Strategic Plan Policy Waiver required

- Prop K Request: \$33,405,243
- Leverages \$78M in non-Prop K funds
 - ► 84 replacement vehicles
 - ► 14 expansion vehicles
 - Amendment to base contract to be awarded in June 2015
 - First vehicle in revenue service in December 2015, all vehicles delivered by October 2016
- Strategic Plan Policy Waiver required

New Signals Contract 62 (SFMTA) Construction








- 7 New traffic signals, 1 flashing beacon
 - 5 new signal locations recommended in WalkFirst
 - **Open for use: August 2016**
 - Fulfills commitment to allocate FY 15/16 funds

Traffic Signal Conduit (SFMTA) Construction






Prop K Request: \$550,000

- Up to 10 intersections
 - Install subsurface conduit for future new or upgraded traffic signals
 - Coordinated with paving projects scheduled to start in Fall 2015
- Associated signals to be constructed by 2018

Traffic Signal Upgrade Contract 34 [Vision Zero] (SFMTA) Design





- Prop K request: \$518,000
- Total cost (all phases):\$3,300,000
- Upgrades to 14 traffic signals
 - 8 locations on Vision Zero High Injury corridors
- Open for use by June 2018


3rd Street Traffic Signal Detection Upgrade - Phase 1 Construction



- 6th St Bottom of the Hi Mariposa S 20th S D 22nd St 22nd Street Caltrain Tubbs S Potrero Hill 23rd St Warm Water Cove Pa 26th St esar Chavez St estar Chavez St Marin St Marin St Islais Creek leon St Pier 90 American Storad
 - Prop K request: \$300,000
 - Replace cross-traffic detection systems at 12 of 67 intersections along 3rd St.
 - First of 3 phases
 - Replaces video detection with wireless system
 - Improved reliability, accuracy, and easier to maintain
 - Sensitive to both motor vehicles and bicycles
 - Works in conjunction with Vetag light rail vehicle detection

19th Avenue Signals Phase III (SFMTA) Design





- Prop K request: \$630,000
- Total cost (all phases): \$3,150,000
 - Upgrades to 9 signals between SFSU to the Presidio
- Partnership with Caltrans
 - SFMTA: 5 signals
 - Caltrans: 4 signals
- Part of the 19th Avenue Combined City Project. Coordinated with:
 - City's 19th Ave. bulb-out project
 - ► Caltrans' 19th Ave. resurfacing project

Local-Track Application-Based Traffic Calming (SFMTA)





- Prop K Request: \$203,400
- Third cycle of annual program
- Planning and conceptual design
 - Evaluate up to 100 applications (due August 1, 2015), prioritize list
 - Project development (e.g. device selection, balloting, additional outreach)
 - Conceptual design of up to 25 locations
- Prop K request for detailed design and construction in early 2016, project completion by the end of 2016



6th Street Pedestrian Safety Improvement (SFMTA)

- Prop K Request: \$2.012 million
 - Focused Environmental Impact Report (EIR)
 - 6th Street between Market and Bryant & Golden Gate between Jones and Market
 - Road diet to calm traffic and add bulb outs, raised crosswalks, and other streetscape improvements
- **Based on comprehensive community** outreach and recommendations from **WalkFirst**
- **Contract award in fall 2015 with** anticipated duration of 18 – 36 months

Bicycle Facility Maintenance (SFMTA) Construction







- Prop K Request: \$150,000
- Upgrade or maintain bike facilities at high-need locations
 - Replace 400 safe-hit posts
 - Upgrade/maintain green bike lanes and bike boxes
 - Test new, more substantial types of safe-hit posts
 - Coordinate with SFPW on testing power washing techniques for green bike boxes
- Complete by Summer 2016

Public Sidewalk Repair (SFPW) Construction





- Prop K Request: \$514,349
- Repair tree-related sidewalk
 damage at 220 locations
- Leverages state funds
 - ► Total cost \$745,470
 - ► 320 locations repaired in total
- All work done by June 2016

Tree Planting and Maintenance (SFPW)






- Prop K Request: \$1,045,000
- Planting 325 trees
- Establish over 620 young trees
- Maintain 780 mature trees
- In public rights-of-way maintained by DPW
- Prop K leverages state and local funds, overall cost of \$4.7 million
- All work done in FY 15/16

Transbay Tube Cross-Passage Doors Replacement (BART) - Design





Transbay Tube Evacuation Instructions

Walk to the nearest door through the passageway to the opposite trackway.



- Prop K Request: \$160,000
- Replacement of 40-year-old cross-passage doors in the Transbay Tube
- Doors are means of emergency egress
- Up to 10 doors on SF side of Transbay Tube
- Design to be completed by March 2016
- Fulfills commitment to allocate FY 15/16 funds

Southwest Subway (19th Avenue/M Ocean View) – Pre-Environmental Supplement (SFMTA)



- Prop K request: \$255,700
- Continues work of TA-led 19th Avenue Transit Study
- Original scope of pre-environmental work funded by \$306,000 in Prop K in March 2014
 - Preparation of Caltrans project initiation documentation (PSR-PDS)
- Supplemental funds to cover additional conceptual engineering work essential to this phase
- Cost for all phases: ~\$420-780 mil



Neighborhood Transportation Improvement Program (NTIP) Support (SFCTA/SFMTA)







- Prop K Request: \$150,000 (50%/50% for SFCTA/SFMTA)
- NTIP support includes:
 - Assist with commissioners' efforts to identify potential NTIP planning and capital projects
 - Develop scope, schedule, and budget for allocation of NTIP grants
 - Provide ongoing support for implementation

Alemany Interchange Improvement Study [NTIP Planning] (SFCTA/SFMTA)





- Prop K Request: \$100,000
 - ▶ \$87,400 SFCTA to lead
 - \$12,600 SFMTA support
- District 9 NTIP study includes:
 - new multimodal pathway to Farmer's Market
 - new Alemany Blvd. bike lanes (pending \$100,000 from General Fund)
 - Completion: June 2016
