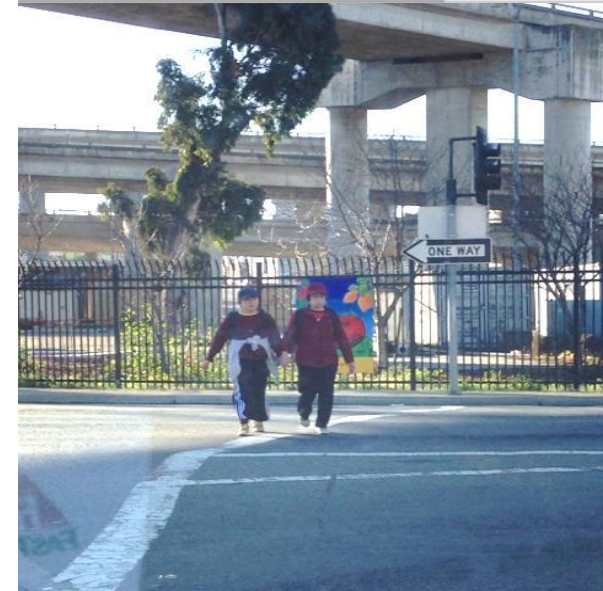

- ▶ **Geary and Geneva-Harney BRT**
- ▶ **Chinatown Neighborhood Transportation Plan**
- ▶ **Neighborhood Transportation Improvement Program (NTIP)**
 - ▶ D9: Alemany interchange
 - ▶ Others: D1, D2, D10, etc.



SFCTA Draft FY 15/16 Work Program Fund



- ▶ **SFCTA is giving safety high priority across all fund programs**
 - ▶ Prop K sales tax, Prop AA vehicle registration fee, OneBayArea grant
- ▶ **Projects span the 24-near term projects, Safe Routes to School, Large Vehicle Driver Training Program**
- ▶ **Funding and legislative advocacy for Vision Zero at regional, state and federal levels**

 - ▶ 19th Avenue Bulbouts , M-Line
- ▶ **TA- Project Delivery Support**
 - ▶ Help ensure timely use of funds, coordinate among Caltrans, FHWA, MTC, local agencies
