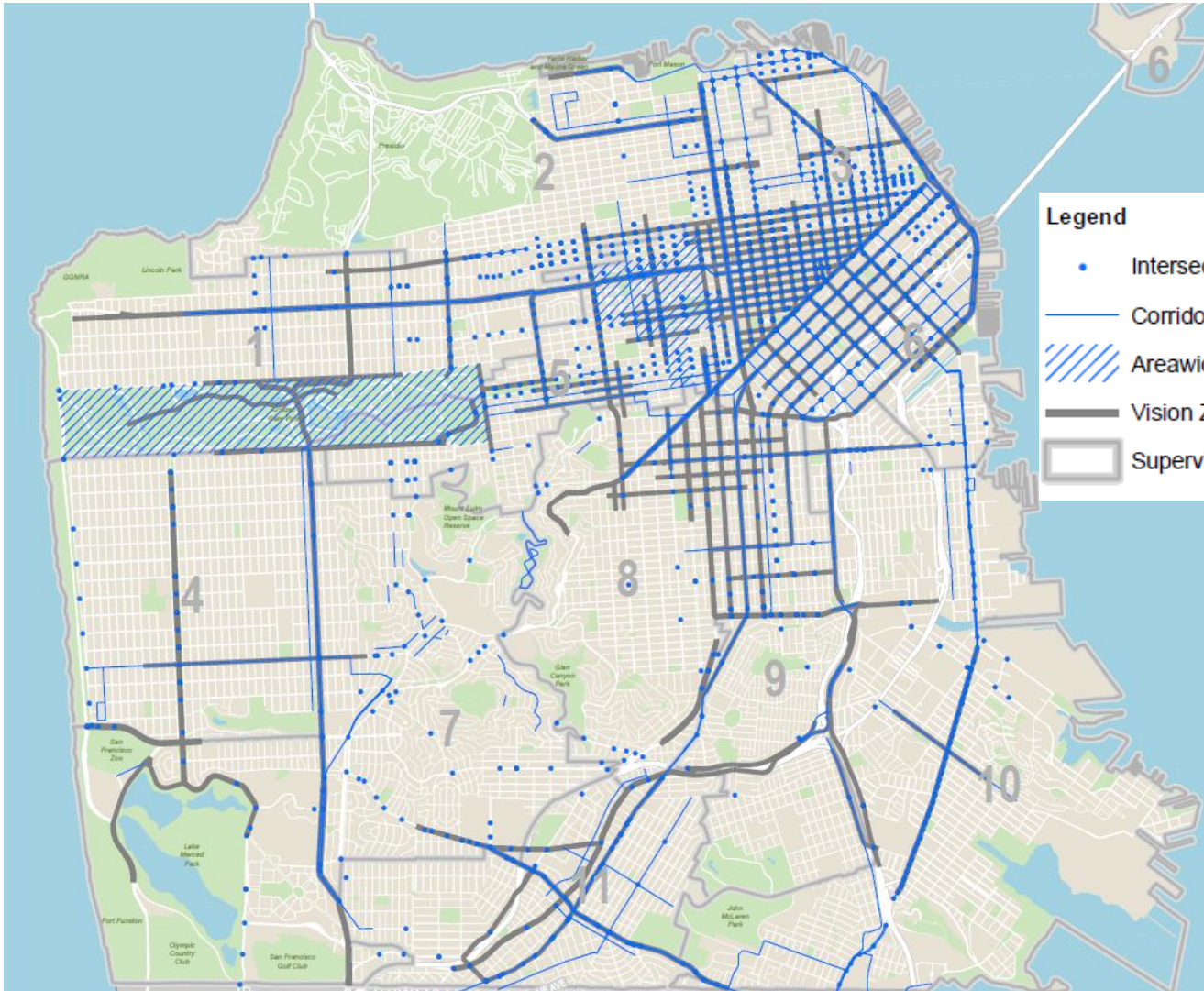

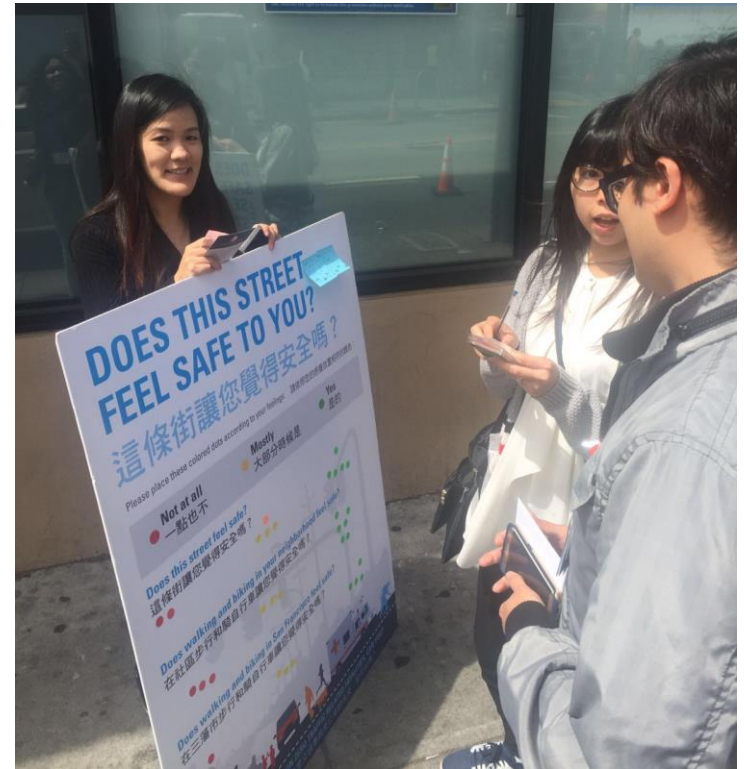

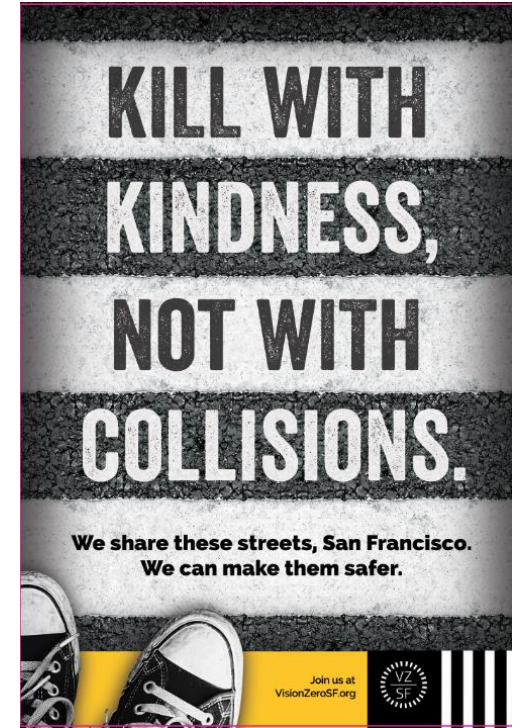

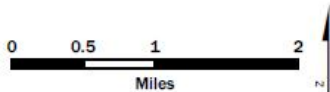




EDUCATION COMBINED WITH ENFORCEMENT
