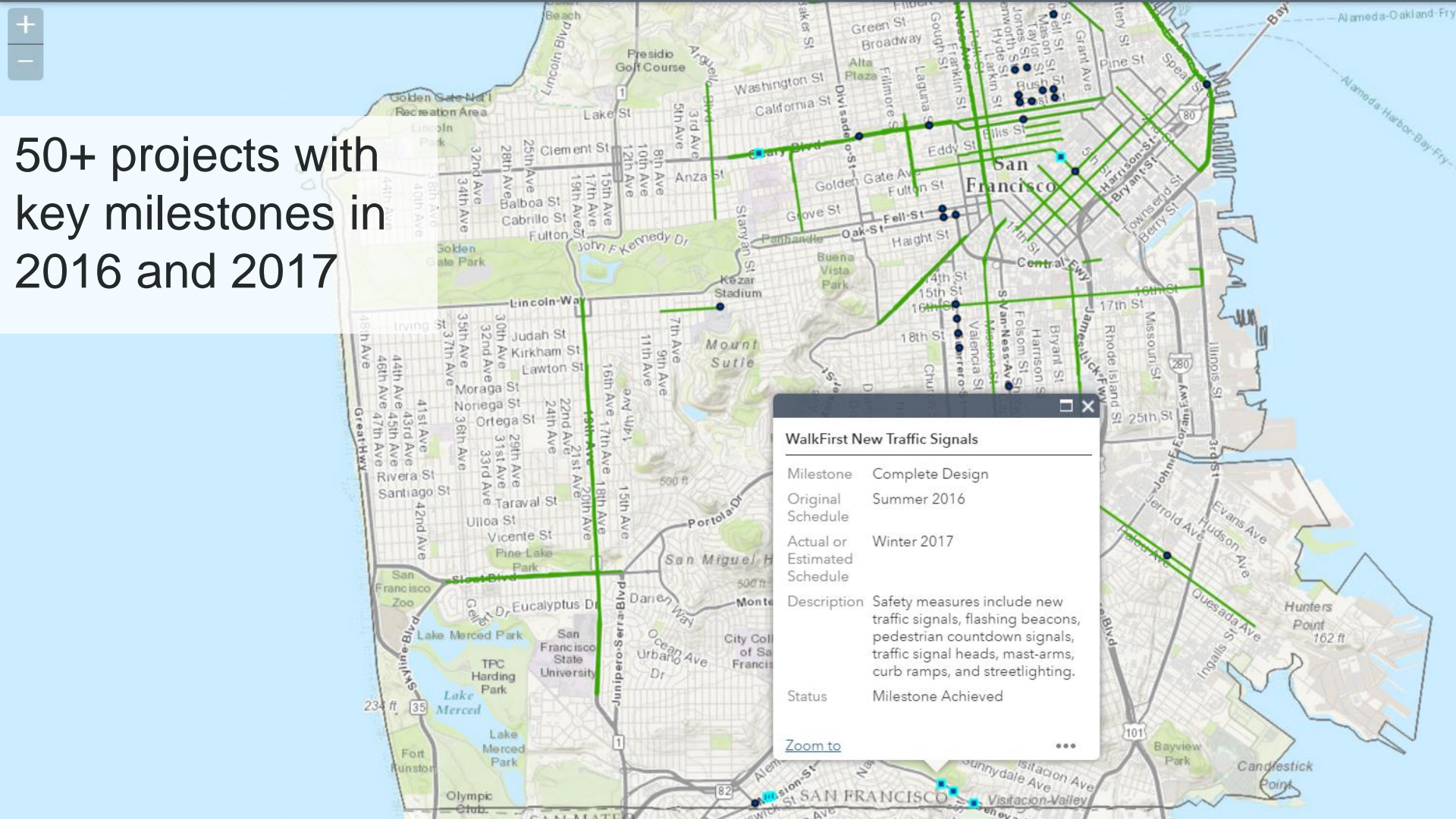

Data Systems:

- ***High Injury Network*** updated to include linked SFPD and ZSFG Hospital Data
- ***Severe Injury Protocol*** developed by SFDPH, SFPD, and SFMTA for consistent monitoring of severe injuries in support of Vision Zero
